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## Erratum

After publication of the original article [1], the authors noticed an error in the 'Methods' section. Within the 'Patients' sub-section, the first item in the list of synthetic or highly processed xenogeneic bone substitutes (SBS) should have been given as Orthoss<sup>®</sup>, rather than BioOss<sup>®</sup>. The sentence should therefore have read as follows:

"The following SBS were used: Orthoss" (Geistlich, Wolhusen, Switzerland) in 41.4 %, and at clearly lower percentages, respectively: Norian SRS" (Synthes) (8.6 %), Chronos" (Synthes) (1.7 %), Atlantik" (Argomedical) (2.6 %), Alaska" (Argomedical) (0.9 %), Endobone" (Biomet) (4.3 %), Pyrost" (Stryker) (0.9 %), Nanostim" (Medtronic) (37.1 %), Actifuse" (Baxter) (0.9 %), Tutobone" (Novomedics) (0.9 %) and PerOssal" (Botiss) (0.9 %)."

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
